

Civic Leadership Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Blue Island Area Chamber of Commerce & Industry is pleased to announce our annual scholarship program for Civic Leadership. Each spring, the Chamber will grant two \$500 scholarships. In addition to completing this application form, applicants will be required to submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, or employer, and an essay.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Eligibility is limited to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Applicants who are US citizens or permanent residents
- Seniors currently enrolled at Dwight D. Eisenhower High School, with plans to continue education or training at a US college, university, or professional/grad school, vocational or on-the-job training post-graduation.
- Applicants who have a minimum GPA of 3.0

<u>The Application and Attachments</u>: Please provide detailed answers to the application questions and submit all required attachments. All information received from applicants will be maintained in confidence.

Required materials for a complete application:

- A completed application form (pages 2 and 3 of this packet)
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, or employer
- An essay (not to exceed 700 words) addressing the following prompt:

Describe why you believe in civic leadership and volunteering and share your experience in giving back to your school, church, community or a charitable organization. In addition, describe why and how you feel the scholarship will help you reach your goals.

<u>Deadlines</u>: The application deadline is February 21, 2025. Honorees will be recognized at the Best of Blue Island Awards Dinner taking place March 15, 2025 at The Lyric Theater.
